PEBA is committed to providing the information you need to administer your employees' insurance benefits. Here's a quick look at the available resources.

- Employee Benefits Services EBS is a secure website that provides authorized users with access to PEBA's insurance benefits enrollment database. Users can view their employees' insurance enrollment information, enroll subscribers, make changes to subscribers' coverage, approve subscriber changes made through MyBenefits, and view reporting data and billing reports. For help with EBS access, call 803.734.2352.
- **Benefits Administrator Manual** PEBA publishes the <u>Benefits Administrator Manual</u> every year to provide updated information about administering PEBA's insurance programs.
- Publications The *Insurance Summary* provides a high-level overview of insurance benefits for active employees. The Summary, *Insurance Benefits Guide* and other publications are available at peba.sc.gov/publications.
- Training and resources We encourage you to review the employer training courses available at peba.sc.gov/insurance-training. We announce online sessions in PEBA Update, and registration is not required.
- **Employer Advisory Group** Learn about recent employer updates, receive answers to questions and provide feedback. We announce online sessions in *PEBA Update*, recorded employer trainings and registration is not required.
- PEBA Health Hub The PEBA Health Hub provides ready-to-use toolkits and other information for you to download and share with your employees.
- YouTube channel <u>PEBA TV</u> features a variety of videos about PEBA-administered benefits, including our <u>Navigating Your Benefits</u> videos.
- **PEBA Update** PEBA uses the employer contact information in <u>EBS</u> to distribute *PEBA Update*, a weekly employer e-newsletter and time-sensitive emails. Please periodically review and update your employer contacts. Previous editions of *PEBA Update* are <u>archived online</u>.
